

# Mark The Monkey Hat



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**Circumference:** 15.75"

**Length:** 6.75"

## Material

1 ball Gorro kids color 9694 (Mark the monkey)

Knitting needles 8

**Gauge:** 18 S x 20 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern chart using needles 8.

## Disclaimer

Measurements are approximate due to differences between centimeters and inches, needle sizes and tension (gauges).

All care has been taken to allow accurate completion of the pattern.

## Hat

Start at rib.

CO 75 sts onto needles 8 and work in 1x1 Rib. At 0.75" start following Pattern - chart. Once chart is completed, mk 1 row in k2tog. Cut yarn, leave a long tail and insert this tail into tapestry needle and pass through all loops of last row and pull all loops together.

**Finishing:** sew side and join pompom animal on top as shown in the picture.

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

st: stitches

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

CN: cable needle

rep: repeat

mk: make

dec: decreases

inc: increases

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

K: knit

P: purl

1x1 Rib: Row 1: \*K1, P1\*. Row 2 and all even rows: knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches.

Pattern: follow chart
