

Cameo Skirt & Top Set

Size: 4

Material

Circulo Yarns

Charme - 2 balls color #3201 cameo Encanto Slim - 3 balls color #3201 cameo

Crochet hook C-2.

4 buttons 0.40" diameter Sewing needle and thread

White glue

Scissors, measuring tape and tapestry needle.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st make: mk skip: sk chain: ch slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

sc back loop only: sc (BLO) half double crochet: hdc

double crochet: dc Increase: inc decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor. Pattern A - chart 1

Pattern B - chart 2

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Pattern C - chart 3

Pattern D - chart 4

Pattern E - chart 5

Pattern F - chart 6

Pattern G - chart 7

Gauge: 20 dc x 9 R = $4^{\prime\prime}/10$ cm using hook

C-2.

Cropped top: Use Charme color #3201 Cameo.

Start at rib. Crochet back and forth.

Ch 6.

Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts up to

26.5". Fasten off.

Join yarn into upper part of this band.

Follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts (129 sts per row) up to 6.25" then make 2 rows following Pattern C - chart 3 and rep sts (64 motifs + 1 dc).

Sides: follow Pattern D - chart 4. Make 1 row onto sides.

Chain cords (make 2): Make 2 chain cords (41.5" each). Sew them 8" apart (see measurement chart). Make straps and criss cross into loops of chart 4.

Crochet fringe tassel (make 65): Use Encanto Slim color #3201 Cameo. Cut 3 strands to 8.25" insert hook in place, fold yarn in half, pull yarn into dc of rnd 1 of Pattern D, pull edges and release (1 tassel) repeat as many times it is required. Use glue to secure each knot.

Skirt: Use Charme color #3201 Cameo. Start at waistline. Crochet back and forth. Ch 8

Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts up to 26". Fasten off.

Join yarn at the bottom of this band. Crochet back and forth.

R1 - 6: follow Pattern E - chart 5 (back and forth).

Flatten piece and divide into front and

Crochet in the round.

R1 - 21: follow Pattern F - chart 6 and rep sts. Number of stitches per rnd:

R1 = 168 sts

R2-6=171 sts in each rnd.

R7 - 10 = 172 sts in each rnd.

R11 - 19 = 173 sts in each rnd.

R20 & 21 = 174 sts in each rnd.

R22 = 175 sts.

Finishing: Follow Pattern G - chart 7 along right side of the back opening.


Make 24 sc on the left side and use sewing needle and thread to sew the 4 buttons.

Crochet fringe tassel - 1st tier (make

65): Use Encanto Slim color #3201 Cameo. Cut 3 strands to 11.5",insert hook in place, fold yarn in half, pull yarn into dc of rnd 4 of Pattern E - chart 5, pull edges and

release (1 tassel) repeat as many times it is required. Use glue to secure each knot.

Crochet fringe tassel - 2nd tier (make 71): Use Encanto Slim color #3201 Cameo. Cut 3 strands to 13",insert hook in place, fold yarn in half, pull yarn into dc of rnd 2 of Pattern E - chart 5, pull edges and release (1 tassel) repeat as many times it is required. Use glue to secure each knot.





La Belle Vest

Created by: Vera Jima

Size: 6

Material

Circulo yarns - La Belle
3 balls color #5368 pine tree
Knitting needles 3 and 8
Measuring tape, scissors and tapestry
needle.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

st/sts: stitches CO: cast on BO: bind off CN: cable needle

rep: repeat

mk: make dec: decreases

inc: increases RS: right side WS: wrong side

K: knit P: purl

2x2 Rib st - chart 1 Pattern A - chart 2 Garter st - chart 3

Gauge: $18 S \times 20 R = 4"/10 cm$ over Pattern

B - chart 2 using needles 8.

Front = back (make 2 identical panels)

CO 70 sts onto needles 3. Start at Rib.


Follow 2x2 Rib st - chart 1 and rep sts up to 2.5". Inc 11 sts evenly spaced in the last row of rib = 81 sts. Switch to needles 8 and follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts (13 motifs + 3 sts) up to 8". Start armhole shaping: make two borders with 4 sts in Garter st (chart 3). Dec sts before/after these borders. Dec 1 st every 2 rows (5x) = 63 sts. At 11.5" from the beginning start

neckline shaping: B0 the 15 central sts and work sides separately. Dec on the neckline side every 2 rows: 2 sts (4x) and 1 st (6x). At 14.5" from the beginning B0 the remaining 10 sts of each shoulder and set piece aside.

Assembly and finishing:

Use tapestry needle and La belle. Sew left shoulder (4") and leave right shoulder open to make collar.

Collar: Use needles 3 to pick up 100 sts around neckline. Work in 2x2 Rib st (chart 1 and rep sts) up to 1.25". BO all sts, leave a tail for sewing (approx. 10"). Insert this tail into tapestry needle and close collar (1.25") and right shoulder (4"). Sew sides (8"), leave 6.75" open for arms.





Puff-Sleeve Crochet Dress

Artesã: Samara Varela

Size: 6

Material

Circulo yarns - 6 balls of Anne 500 or 12 balls of Anne 250 - color #7148 (Craft)

Crochet hook C-2

1 button (0.25" diameter) Sewing needle & thread

11 yards of round elastic - same color as

the dress

 $1\ 17"$ zipper - same color as the dress

Measuring tape, scissors and tapestry

needle.

Optional: fabric to line dress

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st make: mk skip: sk chain: ch slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

half double crochet: hdc

double crochet: dc treble crochet: tr

tr3tog: 3 tr closed together in different

base sts
Increase: inc
decrease: dec
round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Pattern A - follow chart 1
Pattern B - follow chart 2
Pattern C - follow chart 3

Gauge: 22 S x 6 R = $4^{\prime\prime}/10$ cm over Pattern

A - chart 1 using hook C-2.

Dress Top: Start at waistline. Crochet back and forth.

Ch 67.

Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts (7

motifs

Number of motifs per tier: Tiers 1, 2 and 3: 7 motifs

Tier 4: 9 motifs

Tier 5: dec 1 motif on each side to form

armholes = 7 motifs.

Tiers 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 & 11: 7 motifs.

Tier 12: start neckline shaping: do not work on the central 5 motifs and make 2 motifs on each side. Fasten off and set piece aside.

Back Right: Start at waistline. Crochet back and forth.

Ch 37.

Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts (3

motifs + 1/2 motif)

Number of motifs per tier:

Tiers 1, 2 and 3: 3 motifs + 1/2 motif

Tier 4: 4 motifs + 1/2 motif

Tier 5: dec 1 motif on the right side to form

armholes = 3 motifs + 1/2 motif.

Tiers 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12: 3 motifs + 1/2 motif. Fasten off and set piece aside.

Back Left: Start at waistline. Crochet back and forth.

Ch 37.

Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts (1/2)

motif + 3 motifs)

Number of motifs per tier:

Tiers 1, 2 and 3: 1/2 motif +3 motifs

Tier 4: 1/2 motif + 4 motifs

Tier 5: dec 1 motif on the left side to form

armholes = 1/2 motif + 3 motifs

Tiers 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12: 1/2 motif + 3

motifs Fasten off and set piece aside.

Top assembly: Use tapestry needle and Anne color #7148 craft. Close sides (7"), leave 10" open for arms. Sew shoulders (2.5")

Skirt: Join Anne color #7148 at right back. Crochet both backs and front simultaneously. Crochet back and forth.

R1 - 4: follow chart 2.

Follow Pattern B - 25 motifs - 13 tiers.

Crochet in the round.

Follow Pattern C - chart 3 and rep sts.

Number of motifs per tier:

Tiers 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 & 20: 25 motifs

Tier 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25: 42 motifs.

End with 1 rnd in sc. Fasten off.

Make 1 rnd in sc on the second rnd of tier 20.

Sleeves (make 2): Crochet around armhole. Join color #7148 craft into armhole.

tier 1 - 16: Follow Pattern C - 18 motifs. End cuff with 175 sc. Insert 2 rnds of elastic into this rnd and pull gently = 9.5".

Neckline and back opening finishing: Use crochet hook C-2 and color #7148 craft to make 1 rnd in sc around neckline and back opening.

Lining: Use crochet dress as a template to make slip to wear underneath the dress. Use sewing machine to sew slip together with zipper (17"). Sew button on the left back.
