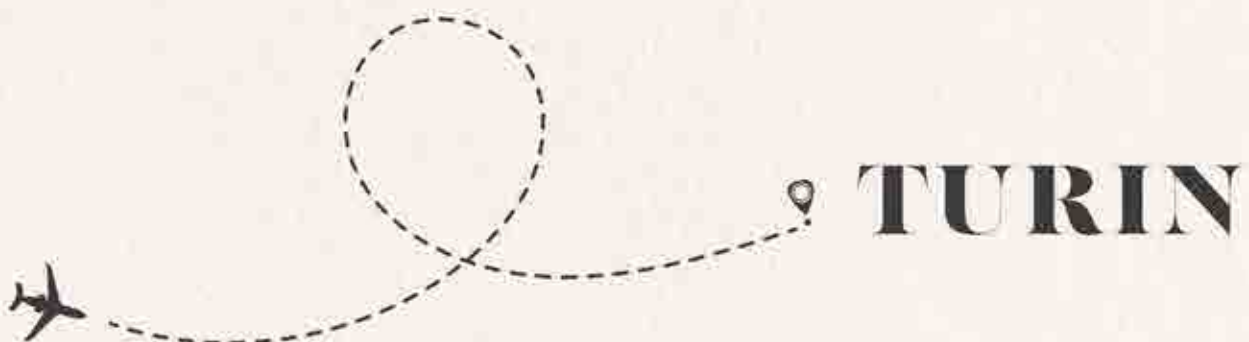

Size: 14

Level: Easy

Material

Circulo yarns - La Belle

8 balls color #3768 (Pretty Girl)

Circular knitting needles 8/5 mm 36" long
Tapestry needle, scissors and measuring tape.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations: st/

sts: stitches

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

rep: repeat

mk: make

dec: decreases

inc: increases

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

K: knit

P: purl

2x2 Rib st - follow chart 1

Pattern A - follow chart 2

Gauge: 15 S x 24 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern A - chart 2 using needles 8/5 mm.

Back/ Front (make 2 identical panels)

CO 82 sts onto needles 8/5 mm. Follow chart 1 - 2x2 Rib st and rep sts up to 5.25". Inc 6 sts evenly spaced in the last row of rib = 88 sts. Follow chart 2 - pattern A and rep sts up to 15". Start sleeves: inc on each side every 6 rows: 3 sts (2x), every 2 rows: 3 sts (2x), every 4 rows: 3 sts (3x), every 2 rows: 6 sts (4x), 3 sts (1x), 6 sts (1x), 3 sts (1x) and 6 sts (2x) = 226 sts onto needles: right sleeves = 69 sts, back = 88 sts and left sleeve = 69 sts.

Assembly and finishing

Use tapestry needle and La Belle to close sleeve on top (18.75") and left shoulder (7"). Leave right sleeve and shoulder open to make collar.

Collar

Pick up 88 sts around neckline and follow Chart 1 - 2x2 Rib st and rep sts up to 4.75". BO all sts with a tail (approx. 31.5"). Insert this tail into tapestry needle and close collar (4.75"), top of right sleeve (18.75") and right shoulder (7").

Cuffs

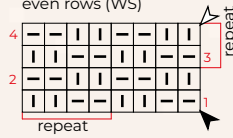
Pick up 44 sts around sleeve and follow chart 1 - 2x2 Rib st and rep sts up to 3.5". BO all sts. Do the same on the other sleeve.

Finishing

Use tapestry needle and La Belle to close the bottom of sleeves (18.75"), cuffs (3.5") and sides (10"). Do not sew Rib section.

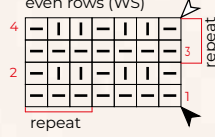



Pattern A**

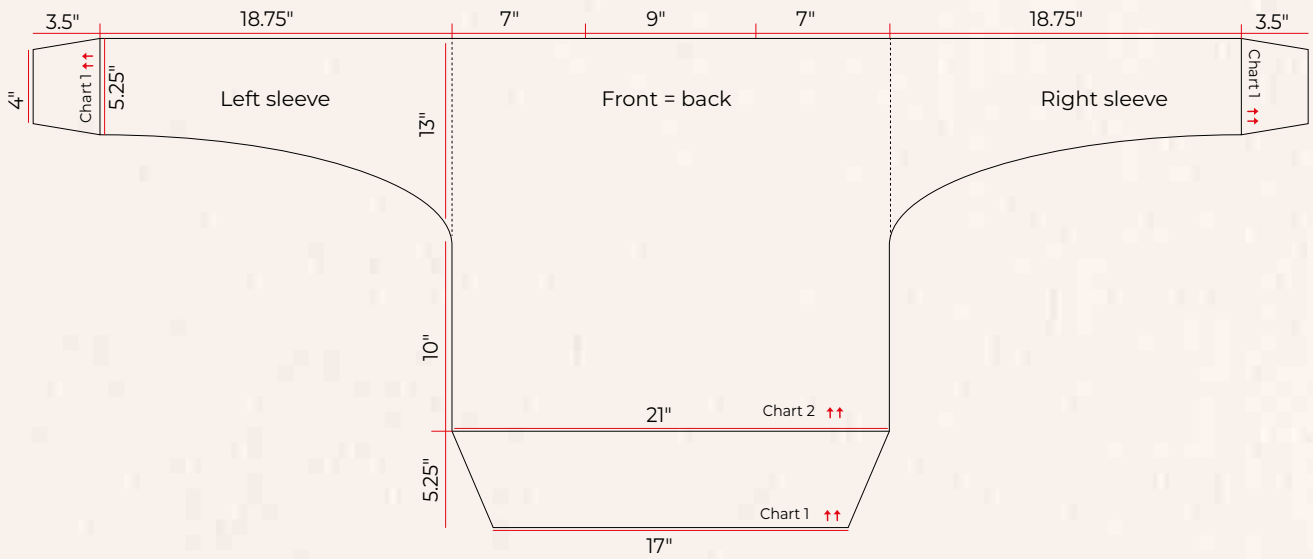
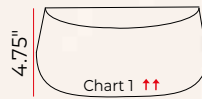

EUROPEAN DRESS



European dress

Size: 14

Level: Intermediate

Material

Circulo yarns - Queen 5

5 balls color #5695 backyard

Circulo yarns - Encanto Slim

10 balls color #5745 eucalyptus

Crochet hook 2 mm and 3 mm

Sewing thread and needle in the same color of dress

Stitch markers

1 8.25" zipper in the same color of the dress

Measuring tape, scissors and tapestry needle

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

double crochet: dc

dc2tog: 2 dc closed tog in different base sts.

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Pattern A, B, C and D: follow respective charts.

Gauge: 27 S x 10 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern D - chart 4 using Queen 5 and hook 2 mm.

Dress

Yoke

Crochet back and forth.

Use Queen 5 and hook 2 mm.

Ch 153.

R1 - 19: follow chart 1 - Pattern A and rep sts.

Flatten piece and use st markers to separate yoke as follows: right back, right armhole, front, left armhole, left back.

Right and left back continuation:

Crochet back and forth.

R20 - 31: follow chart 2.

Work each side separately from R20 - 24 and then crochet both sides at the same time from R25 - 31. Fasten off.

Front continuation: Crochet back and forth.

R20 - 31: follow chart 3 - Pattern C.

Fasten off.

Skirt

Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st. Note: see charts on how to decrease and increase sts.

Join yarn at back center and work as follows:

R32 - 92 motifs

R33 & 34 - 96 motifs

R35: (9 motifs, 1 dec)8x, end rnd with 1 motif.

R36: 5 motifs, 1 dec, 10 motifs, 1 dec, (9 motifs, 1 dec) 2x, 11 motifs, 1 dec, 4 motifs, 1 dec, 10 motifs, 1 dec, 8 motifs, 1 dec, 9 motifs, 1 dec, end rnd with 3 motifs.

R37: 1 dec, 13 motifs, 1 dec, (9 motifs, 1 dec) 4x, 10 motifs, 1 dec, end rnd with 10 motifs.

R38, 39, 40, 41, 42, and 43: 69 motifs

R44: 1 motif, 1 inc, 10 motifs, 1 inc, 11 motifs, 1 inc, 9 motifs, 1 inc, (10 motifs, 1 inc)3x, end rnd with 8 motifs.

R45: 76 motifs.

R46: 1 inc, 15 motifs, 1 inc, 10 motifs, 1 inc, 11 motifs, 1 inc, 10 motifs, 1 inc, 7 motifs, 1 inc, (10 motifs, 1 inc) 2x, end rnd with 2 motifs.

R47: 84 motifs.

R48: 2 motifs, 1 inc, 9 motifs, 1 inc, (10 motifs, 1 inc) 7x, end rnd with 3 motifs.

R49: 93 motifs.

R50: 5 motifs, 1 inc, (7 motifs, 1 inc) 3x, 11 motifs, 1 inc, 6 motifs, 1 inc, (7 motif, 1 inc) 2x, (8 motif, 1 inc) 2x, 6 motifs, 1 inc, 5 motifs, 1 inc, end rnd with 7 motifs.

R51: 105 motifs

R52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59 and 60: 105 motifs.

R61: 1 dec, 54 motifs, 1 dec, end rnd with 52 motifs.

R62: 1 dec, 103 motifs.

R63 & 64: 1 dec, 102 motifs.

R65: 1 inc, 103 motifs.

R66 & 67: 104 motifs.

R68: 1 dec, 103 motifs.

R69: 1 dec, 41 motifs, 1 dec, 61 motifs.

R70: 21 motifs, 1 dec, 41 motifs, 1 motif, 34 motifs, 1 dec, end rnd with 3 motifs.

R71 - 88: 100 motifs in each. Fasten off.

Crochet edge for armholes and back opening

Use crochet hook 2 mm and Queen 5 color #5695 backyard. Make 120 sc around each armhole and 45 sc (on each side) in the back opening.

Hemline crochet edge

Use Encanto Slim color #5745 eucalyptus and hook 3 mm.

Make 200 sc around hemline.

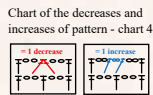
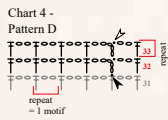
Fringes

Use Encanto Slim color #5745 eucalyptus. Cut 10 strands to 18.5", insert needle in place, fold yarn in half, pull yarn into loop, pull edges and release (1 tassel) repeat as many times it is required. Insert fringes

into front and back (not armholes) of R19 and then insert fringes around R32, 46, 59, and 72.

Finishing

Use sewing thread and needle to sew zipper (8.25") in the back opening.

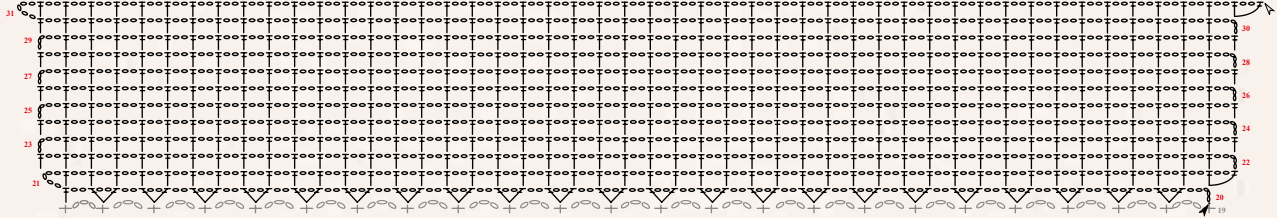

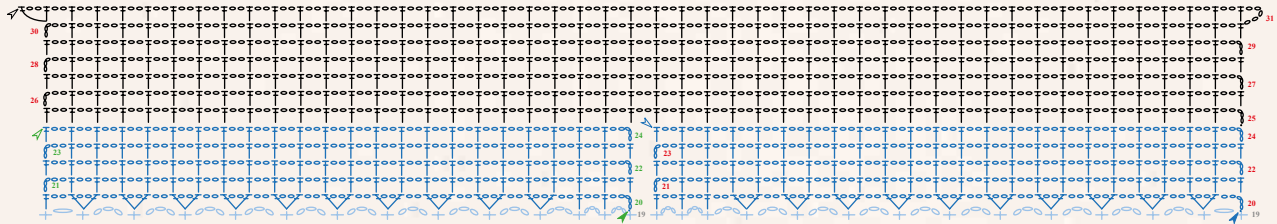
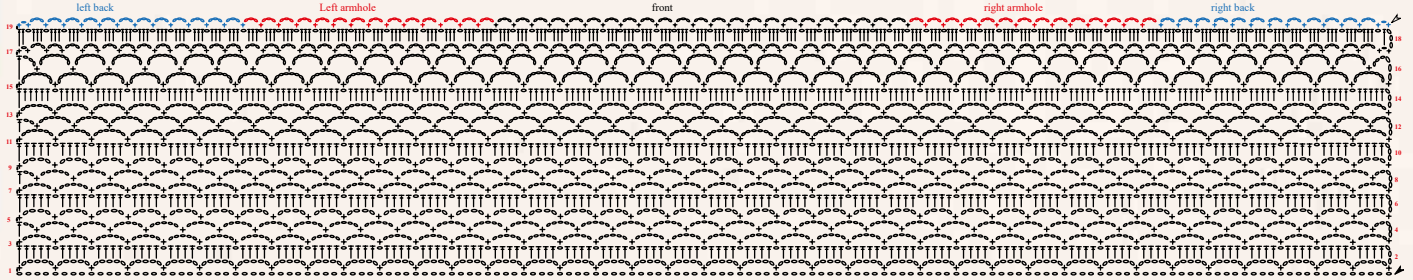
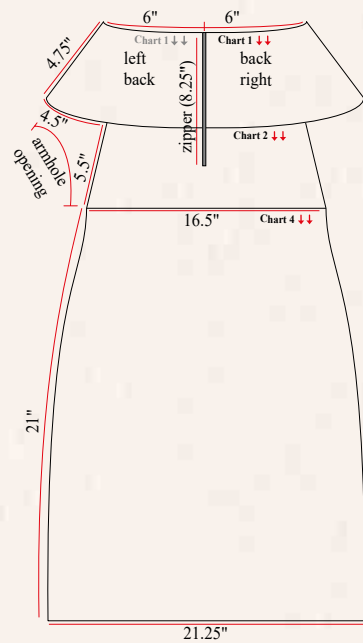


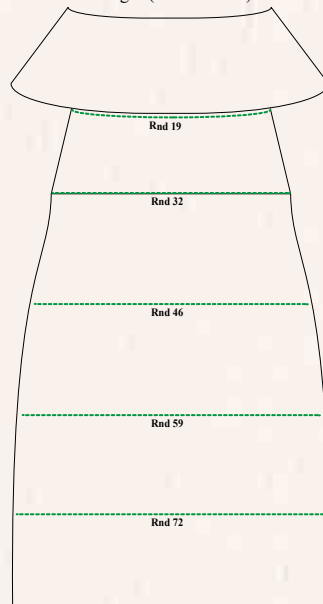
Chart 1 - Pattern A

LA DOLCE VITA DRESS



La dolce vita dress

Created by: *Mariane Machado*

Size: 14

Level: Challenging

Material

Circulo yarns - 8 balls of Anne 500 or 16 balls of Anne 250 - color #2927 (Aquarium)

Crochet hooks: 1.75 mm and 2 mm

Sewing thread and needle

1 15" zipper in the same color of dress

Fabric to line dress

Tapestry needle, scissors and measuring tape.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

half double crochet: hdc

double crochet: dc

treble crochet: tr

tr2tog: 2 tr closed tog in different base sts

3 tr cluster: 3 tr closed tog in the same base st

picot: ch 3, 1 sl st in chain 1

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Pattern A, B, C, D, E, F, G - follow respective charts.

Gauge: 30 dc x 10 R = 4"/10 cm using hook 1.75 mm.

Dress

Part 1 - start at yoke. Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

Ch 204, close ring with 1 sl st.

R1 - 13: follow chart 1 - Pattern A and rep sts.

Flatten yoke and divide into front and back. Use st markers to define armholes (6.75") on each side. Check blue stars onto measurement chart. Join front & back with a chain cord: ch 34 (4.5").

Part 2 - Front & back are worked simultaneously. Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st. Work in 17" of front and 17" of back and in the 4.5" of each chain cord.

R14 - 18: follow chart 2 - Pattern B and rep sts.

Crochet back and forth.

R19 - 50: follow chart 3 - Pattern C and rep sts.

Crochet in the round.

R51 - 95: follow chart 4 - Pattern D and rep sts.

R96 - 118: follow chart 5 - Pattern E and rep sts.

Sleeves (make 2)

Join yarn at armhole. Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

R119 - 160: follow chart 6 - Pattern F and rep sts.

R161 - 168: follow chart 7 - Pattern G and rep sts. Fasten off.

Make the other sleeve.

Neckline crochet edge

Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

R1 -3: ch 3, 127 dc.

Zipper: join zipper in the side opening. Note: you can use sewing machine.

Lining

Use crochet dress as a template to make a slip to wear underneath.

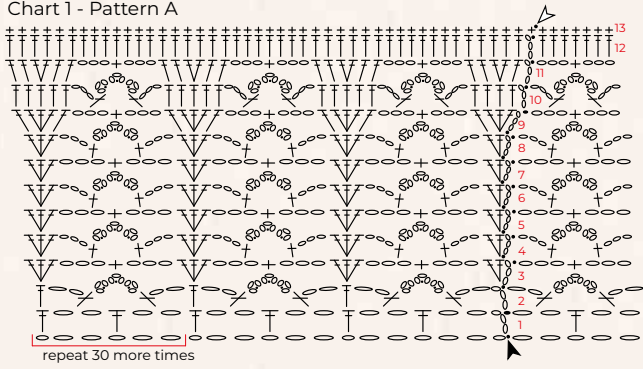


Chart 2 - Pattern B

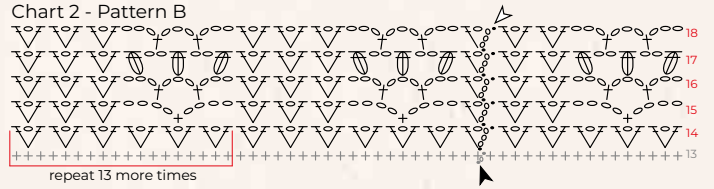


Chart 7 - Pattern G

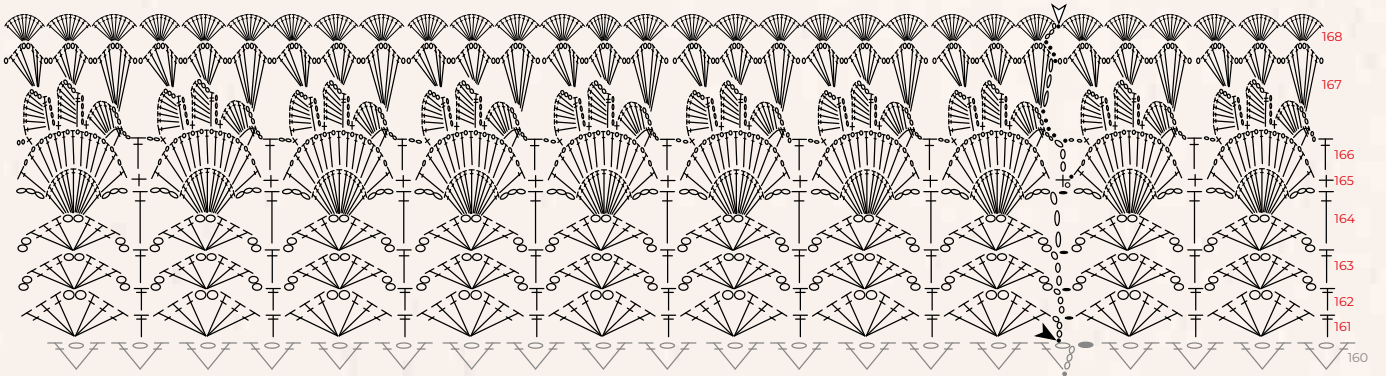


Chart 5 - Pattern E

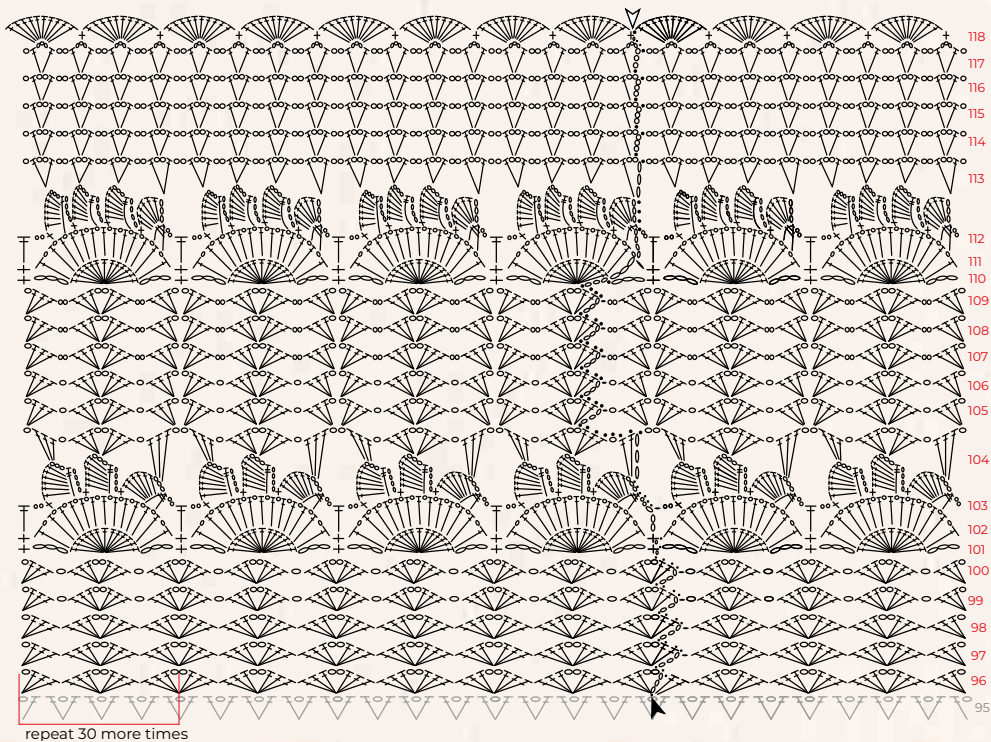

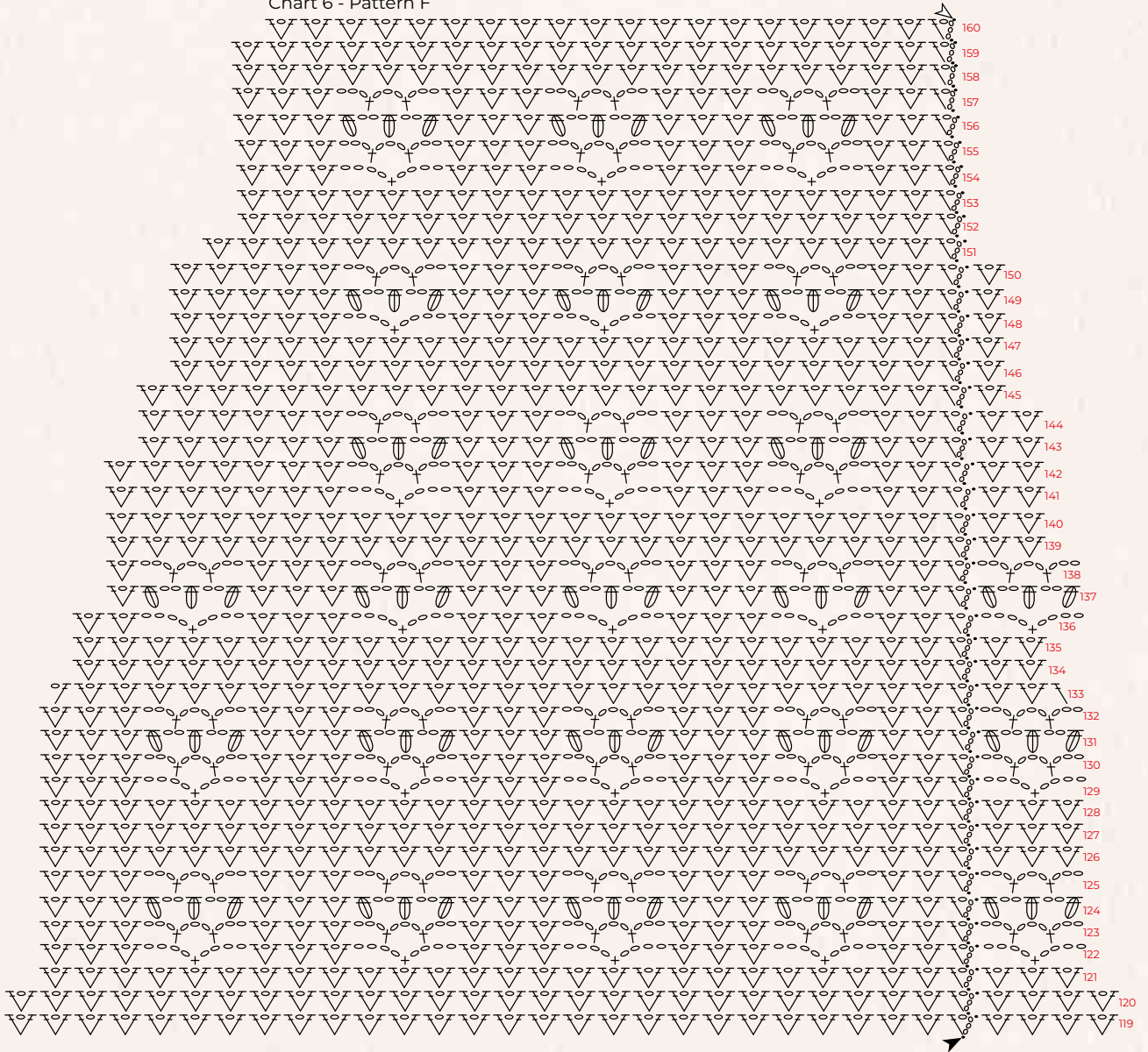
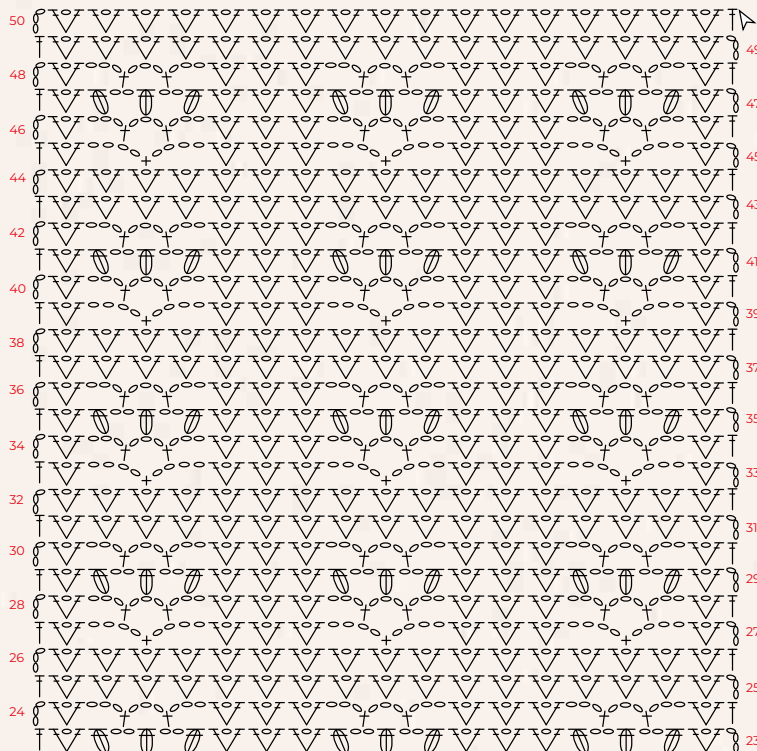


Chart 3 - Pattern C

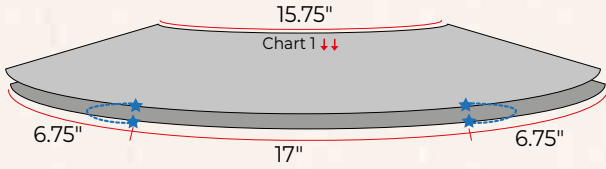

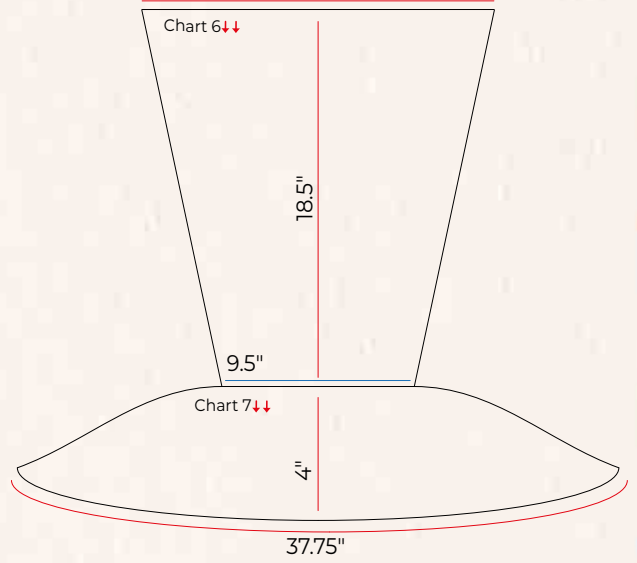
Measurement chart

Part 1 - chart 1

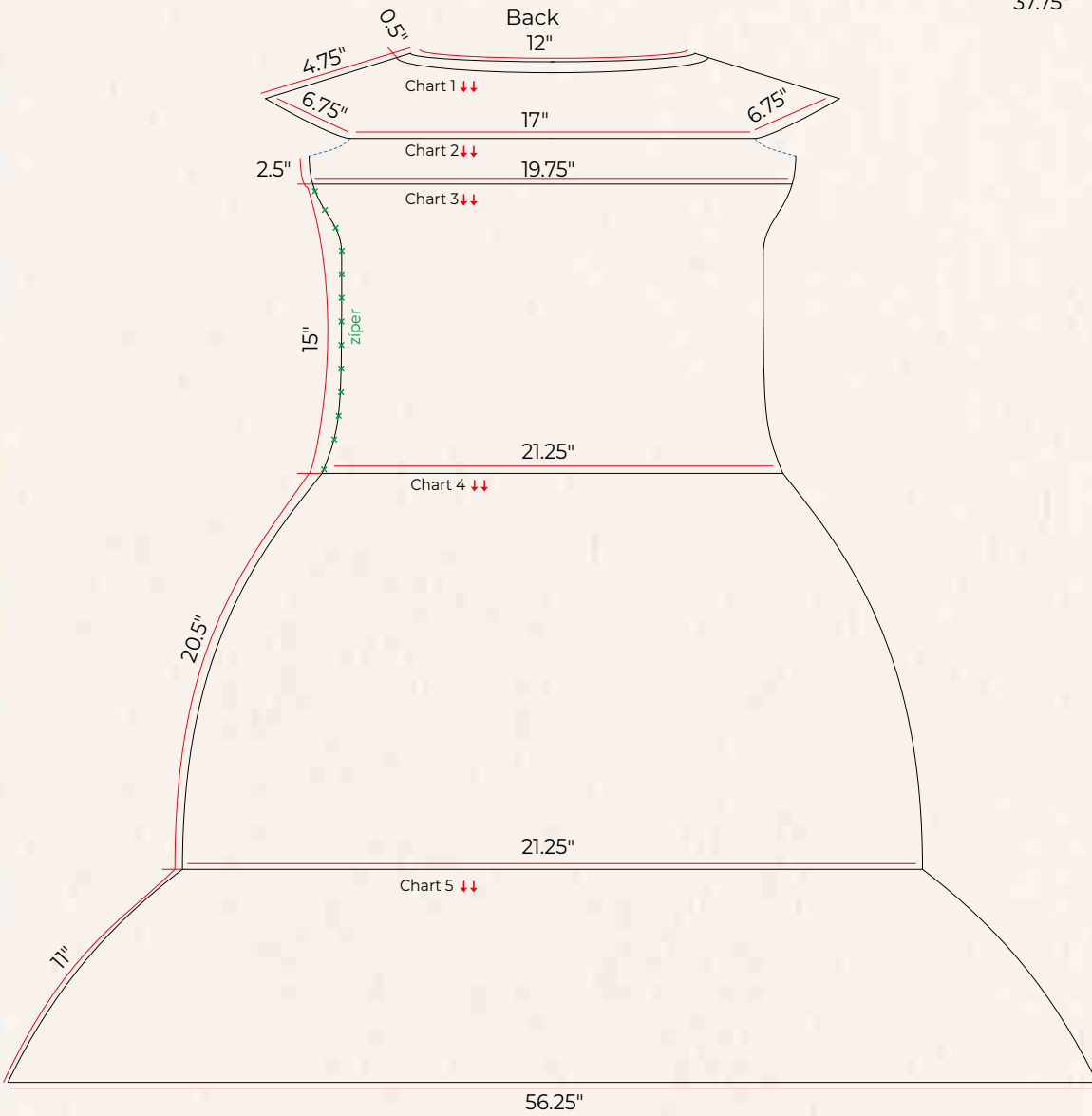
Flatten yoke and divide into front and back. Leave 6.75" for armholes on both sides. Ch 34 to join sides (see blue stars on chart)

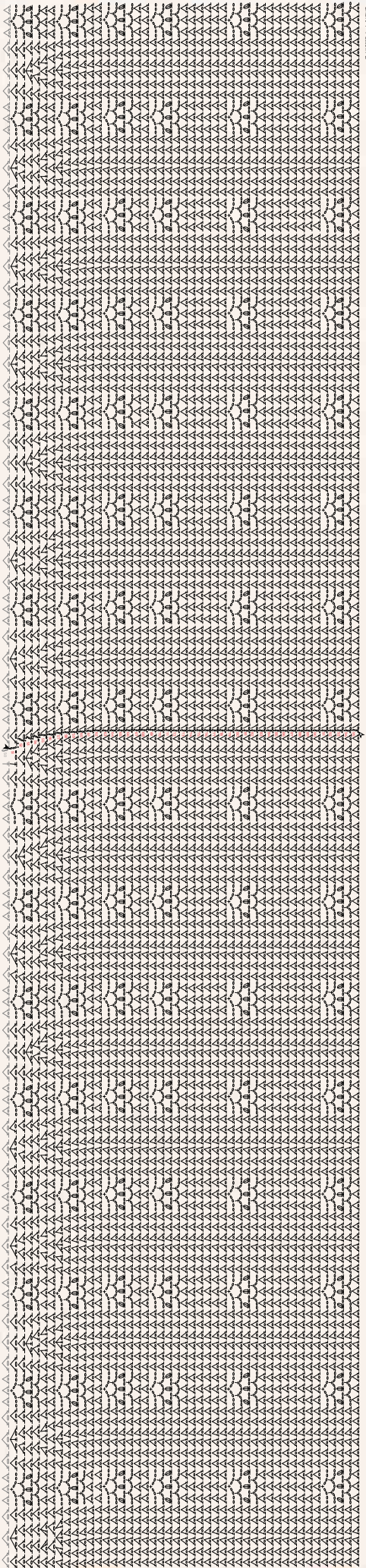

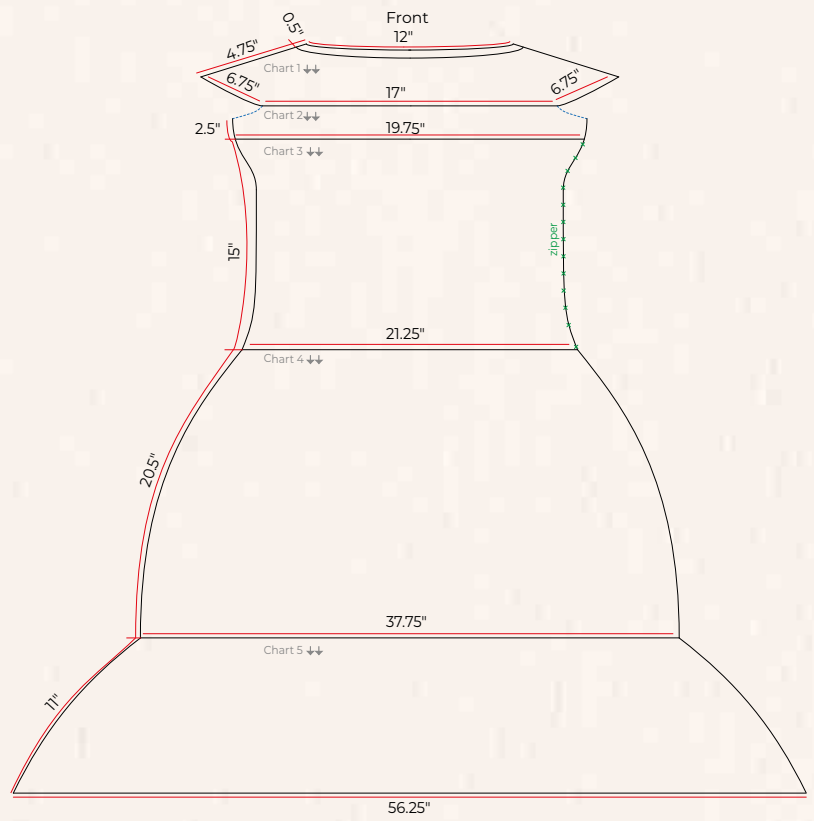


Part 2 (bodice, skirt and sleeves)





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
