

# Kadu hat



**CIRCULO**

**Size: 4 yo - 19.25" circumference x**

**8.75" height**

**Level of difficulty: Easy**

### Material

Circulo Yarns - Gorro kids

1 ball color #9828 kadu

Knitting needles 10/ 6 mm or size to obtain gauge.

Scissors and tapestry needle.

### Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

st/sts: stitches

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

CN: cable needle

rep: repeat

mk: make

dec: decreases

inc: increases

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

K: knit

P: purl

Stockinette Stitch: Knit RS rows and Purl WS rows.

2x2 Rib: Row 1: \*K2, P2\*. Row 2 and all other rows: knit the knit stitches and

purl the purl stitches.

Pattern - follow chart.

**Gauge:** 15 S x 20 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern using needles 10.

**Disclaimer:** Measurements are approximate due to differences between centimeters and inches, needle sizes, and tension. All care has been taken to allow accurate completion of the pattern. CO 72 sts and work in 2x2 Rib st for 1.25". Make 2 rows in Stockinette st and follow pattern up to 8". Start decreasing: 1 row in k2tog = 36 sts, purl all sts on the WS and make another row in k2tog. Cut yarn with a long tail to sew side. Use tapestry needle to insert this tail into loops of the last row, pull, make knots and then sew side. Cut yarn and weave in end. Sew animal topper on top as shown in the picture.
